IT and Site Services Updates

- Orders have been placed with our broadband provider to install upgraded broadband connections to all three sites. This will increase our internet connection significantly and provide a more resilient service. We don't have an install date as yet, but it is on its way.
- Orders have been placed for a replacement printer solution for all three sites. These are due sometime after
 May. A centralised printer management solution (PaperCut) allowing you to print and collect at any copier using
 only your ID badge for authentication. Scanning will require just your ID badge, to inform the copier where to send
 the pdf to.
- IT Security Virus threats Remember if you get an email with an attachment, if it's unexpected, unusual in its request, or simply doesn't read or look right it could be a Phishing / virus email PLEASE if you are unsure <u>DO NOT OPEN IT</u> call Jon on EXT 413 and seek advice.
- You can help with data security and to meet GDPR requirements by remembering to lock your pc or laptop, when you walk away from it
